Minutes:

The Minutes and Actions of the 25th Olympic Board meeting were agreed.

Programme Progress Report:

It was noted that good progress had been made across the four strategic objectives since the previous meeting.

- The ODA were congratulated on signing a contract with Team McAlpine for construction of the Stadium. The Aquatics Centre contract was due to be signed imminently.
- LOCOG had launched their Pre-Games Training Camps manual in March.
- Park Legacy launch event held on 29 February
- The Government's Legacy Action Plan would be published in May.

Beijing Objectives:

NICKY ROCHE, Director, Staging in GOE and Chair of the Beijing Co-ordination Working Group introduced this item.
