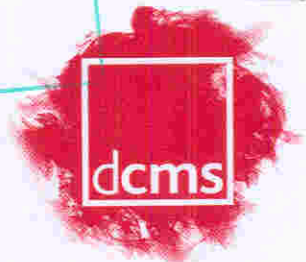



**ENFORCEMENT OF ODA'S COMMITMENTS UNDER THE SECTION 106
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE AUTHORITY AND THE LONDON DEVELOPMENT
AGENCY (AS REFERRED TO BELOW): POWER OF DIRECTION**

I write in relation to the Olympic Delivery Authority's ("the Authority") commitments under a Deed of Agreement between the Authority and the London Development Agency to be entered into in respect of the Olympic Planning Applications (refs. 07/90011/FUMODA and 07/90010/OUMODA) ("the Agreement") made pursuant to, inter alia, section 106 of the Town and Country Development Act 1990.

I can confirm that, in our view, a direction by the Secretary of State or Paymaster General to the Authority to comply with its commitments under the Agreement would fall within the scope of paragraph 18 of Schedule 1 to the London Olympic Games and Paralympic Games Act 2006, as amended by the Transfer of Functions (Olympics and Paralympics) Order 2007 (SI 2007/2129) (power of Secretary of State or Paymaster General to give directions to the Authority). The Authority is required to comply with any direction given by the Secretary of State or Paymaster General under that provision.

Before giving a direction under paragraph 18 of Schedule 1 to the London Olympic Games and Paralympic Games Act 2006, the Secretary of State or Paymaster General would have to be satisfied that it was appropriate to do so, having regard to all of the circumstances prevailing at the time, and would also have to consult the Authority and the Mayor of London in accordance with paragraph 18.
